

# Housing Committee - Terms of Reference

### 1.0 Purpose

To propose legislation and policy changes to the federal, provincial and territorial governments to ensure that all Canadians, particularly aging Canadians have access to adequate affordable housing.

## 2.0 Objectives

To ensure that available and affordable housing is available for all seniors in Canada.

## 3.0 Membership

- a) Four [4 ]members to be elected or appointed by the Executive Board; one of which will be the Chairperson.
- b) A member of the Executive Board will be the committee liaison with voice and vote.

## 4.0 Tactics

- Lobby the government at all levels
- Identify the true statistics regarding the availability of adequate affordable housing for seniors from province to province
- Document this information and provide it in an Executive Board brief to the Federal government
- Seek and join with other like-minded groups and organizations in pursuit of our vision
- The committee will provide a report regarding their progress, actions and future directions to be presented by the chair at the conventions
- To make this issue an ongoing priority until we get the positive attention of our governments.
